Consent to the Sharing of Personal Information

The Congress uses a QR code scanning system for sponsored seminars (including Morning Seminars, Luncheon Seminars, Coffee Break Seminars, Sponsored Symposia, etc.) and the exhibition area. By presenting the QR code printed on your name badge at the scanner located at the entrance to a seminar room or at an exhibition booth, your attendance information will be shared with the relevant sponsoring company. When your QR code is scanned, your name and affiliation will be shared with the relevant sponsoring company.
