English Oral Sessions

Aiming at internationalization of our Society and promotion of international dissemination of information by our members, we call for general topics for oral presentations in English. Speaking time is set to 15 min., longer than for general speeches (10 min.).

Particulars

Applicant eligibility

Applicants must be at age 40 years or younger as of the end of April 2018 and first authors of JES 2018 presentations on general topics residing in Japan and abroad (East Asia, Oceania and North America), regardless of nationality.

Application Method

Please down load the Submission Form from JES2018 website and email to the secretariat (jes2018@c-linkage.co.jp). Deadline for the abstract submission is 30th November, 2017. Please indicate if you wish to apply for the Travel Grants.

Selection Method

JES 2018 President will select a total of up to 18 topics among those of applicants, up to 3 topics in each of 6 fields. Selection will be based on diversity of topics and presenters, in the light of clinical practice (including case reports) or fundamental nature, domestic or abroad location, and other factors.

- 1) Hypothalamus-pituitary system
- 2) Reproduction or cancer
- 3) Thyroid gland
- 4) Parathyroid gland and bone metabolism
- 5) Carbohydrate and lipid metabolism, and gastrointestinal Endocrinology
- 6) Adrenal gland, hypertension and cardiovascular metabolism

Presentation

12 min and Qs and As: 3 min.

Session configuration will be announced at a later date, in view of the number and contents of topics.

Best Topic Awards

Best topic awards will be granted to 3 outstanding presented topics.

Travel Grants

Travel grants will be provided to the selected presenters residing abroad. Amount of Grants will be from JPN100,000 to 150,000 depending on the number of applications and the applicant's area of residence. The organizing committee will review and select the Travel Grant recipients. The grant recipients will be notified from the secretariat.

Presentation

Slides, speeches, and Qs and As must be in English only.
