

Located less than an hour by car from the hotel, Kirishima Shrine stands amid a sacred forest of towering black pines on the Kirishima mountain range. It is a spiritual power spot symbolizing southern Kyushu, radiating an aura of divine reverence from ancient times. The tour continues to **Chin Jukan Kiln**, one of the few remaining original kiln sites in Kagoshima. There, you will enjoy a traditional lunch before visiting the beautiful **Sengan-en**, a stately garden registered in 2015 as part of the "Sites of Japan's Meiji Industrial Revolution" on the UNESCO World Heritage List. The expansive garden of approx. 15,000 m² and scenic views await you.

■ Chin Jukan Kiln

One of Kagoshima’s few original kilns, operating since potters arrived from Korea in 1598. It still produces traditional works using rare techniques like Satsuma white porcelain and Kuro Satsuma, which you can see and enjoy firsthand.



■ Sengan-en

Built in 1658 by Shimazu Mitsuhiba, Sengan-en is a spacious garden with views of Sakurajima and Kinko Bay. It features ponds and shrines, was favored by the Shimazu clan, appeared in the TV drama Segodon, and includes a World Heritage industrial site.

This tour offers you the opportunity to fully enjoy both a visit to **Sakurajima** and a leisurely stroll through **Tenmonkan**. You will first take in the spectacular views of Sakurajima — the iconic symbol of Kagoshima that remains an active volcano — from scenic parks and aboard a ferry. At the Sakurajima Lava Nagisa Park, you can relax in a 100-meter-long footbath while admiring the stunning scenery of Kinko Bay and the mountain ridges of Sakurajima. Afterward, enjoy some free time to explore Tenmonkan at your own pace. The tour concludes with a delightful meal featuring Kagoshima's local specialties at the restaurant Satsumaji.

■ **Sakurajima Ferry**
The ferry connects Kagoshima Port and Sakurajima Port in approximately 15 minutes. Enjoy a scenic ride with breathtaking views of Sakurajima from Kinko Bay. Be sure to spend some time on the deck and feel the refreshing sea breeze.



■ **Tenmonkan**
A popular shopping and entertainment district in southern Kyushu, Tenmonkan offers local specialties like black pork tonkatsu, Kagoshima ramen, and shirokuma shaved ice. It also features cafés and plenty of shops for souvenirs.
