- “Professionals in other medical fields” also includes nurses, pharmacists, radiologists, clinical engineers, physiotherapists and occupational therapists. The abstracts will be available on our website before the conference or via a mobile application. The password to view the abstracts will be provided in the program booklet (P25).

Regular registration

- Regular registration is available from February 7th (Mon.) to noon, March 31st (Thu.) via the homepage, payable by credit card only (VISA, MasterCard, American Express, Diners Club). You can register during the meeting dates, February 17th (Thu.) to 19th (Sat.), but to avoid congestion, we ask that you register yourself online before it begins.
- If you register as an undergraduate student or an intern, or non-industry medical professionals, please upload your proof of identifications such student/hospital ID cards on the registration system
- If you are a medical staff or a graduate student, please upload a certificate of employment, hospital card, student ID card, or other proof of identity with your department head's seal to the registration system.
- If you are a student or early career trainee, please upload proof of employment (voluntary form), hospital ID card or other proof of identity to the registration system.
- If you are a medical staff graduate student, please upload proof of employment, hospital card, student ID card or other proof of identity with your department head's seal into the registration system.
- An electronic receipt will be emailed to you at the end of the event.
